TOWN OF FLORENCEVILLE-BRISTOL A BY-LAW ESTABLISHING A PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE BY-LAW NO. 10

The council of the Town of Florenceville-Bristol, under authority vested in it by subsection (1) of section 12 of the *Community Planning Act*, enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

This by-law may be cited as the Town of Florenceville-Bristol Planning Advisory Committee by-law.

2. ADVISORY COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED

A planning advisory committee, consisting of five members, is established.

3. BY-LAW REPEALED

By-law No. 5, <u>A By-law to Establish a Planning Advisory Committee</u>, of the former Village of Florenceville and amendments thereto, given third reading on May 1, 1973, is hereby repealed and By-law No. 4, <u>A By-law to Establish a Planning Advisory</u> <u>Committee</u>, of the former Village of Bristol and amendments thereto, given third reading on August 5, 1974, is hereby repealed.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE

By-law No. 10, A By-law of the Municipality of Florenceville-Bristol to establish a Planning Advisory Committee comes into effect on the date of filing in the Registry Office.

PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- 1. The council of each Town, which is not in a planning district, is required to establish by by-law a planning advisory committee, to be known as the "advisory committee."
- 2. The advisory committee is to consist of five members, being persons eligible to vote under the Municipal Act and resident in the municipality, appointed by resolution of the council.
- 3. One member of the advisory committee is to be a councillor or servant of the municipality.
- 4. The resolution appointing the members should designate the chairman and vicechairman, whose term as such is one year.
- 5. Although the term of office of members is three years, original appointments are made in such manner that the term of a member expires on the first day of January each year.
- 6. The attached model by-law may be used for the purposes of establishing the advisory committee.
- 7. The resolution of the council to appoint members to the advisory committee might read as follows.

<u>RESOLVED</u>, that the following members are appointed to the advisory committee for the terms indicated:

A.	Member #1 (Chairperson)	until January 1, 20
В.	Member #2 (Vice-Chairperson)	until January 1, 20
C.	Member #3	until January 1, 20
D.	Member #4	until January 1, 20
E.	Member #5	until January 1, 20

CARRIED

- 8. At the first meeting of the council during 20____, the council should re-appoint or replace the member whose term has expired and at the same time, designate or redesignate the officers for the year.
- 9. The council may remove any member of the advisory committee.
- 10. If the member who is a councillor or servant of the municipality ceases to be a councillor or servant, he ceases to be a member of the advisory committee unless the council fails to appoint another person to replace him/her.

11. A person appointed to replace a member is to be appointed for the remainder of the term of the member he/she replaces.
