

BY-LAW NO. S - 4

A BYLAW RESPECTING DANGEROUS AND UNSIGHTLY PREMISES

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Bath as follows:

- 1. Section 190.001 to 190.07 of the Municipalities Act, Chapter, M -22, RSNB, 1973, with amendments thereto, applies to the whole area within the village limits of the Village of Bath.**
- 2. By-Law No. 22A, A Bylaw Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, passed on June 12, 2006, with amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.**
- 3. The repeal of Bylaw No. 22A, A Bylaw Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability , incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.**
- 4. Bylaw No. S-1, A Bylaw Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, passed on July 14, 2008, with amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.**
- 5. Bylaw No. S-2, A Bylaw Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, passed on September 8, 2008, with amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.**

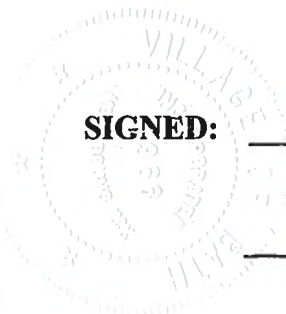



Under subsection 8(1) of the Unsightly Premises Act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, being of the opinion that there is a by-law in force in the municipality of the Village of Bath which provides satisfactorily for the regulating of unsightly premises, suspends the operation of sections 3 to 7 and section 10 of the Unsightly Premises Act in the municipality of the Village of Bath.

2. Under subsections 8(1) and 8(3) of the Unsightly Premises Act and section 26 of the Interpretation Act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council amends Order in Council 80-554 dated July 10, 1980 by striking out the word "Bath".
