

**BYLAW NO. S-8**

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A CURFEW**

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Bath under the authority vested in it by the Municipalities Act R.S.N.B. 1973, C. M-22, as follows:

**DEFINITIONS**

1. In this Bylaw

“Child” means a person who is or, in the absence of evidence to the contrary, appears to be under the age of 16.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

2.01 No child under the age of 16 years shall be in a public place in the village after the hour of 11 p.m. unless they are accompanied by a parent or guardian.

2.02 A child below the age of 16 years or apparently so, who is found in a public place after the time appointed, may be ordered to their home by a constable or peace officer, and in case of refusal they may be dealt with as a child in need of protection under the Family Services Act, with amendments thereto,

**PENALTIES**

3. Parent or guardian who permits their child to violate any provision of this bylaw commits an offence punishable under Part II of the Provincial Offences Procedures Act as a Category B offence.
