



2024 SPECIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION SCHEDULE



Western Valley Regional Service Commission

Week of May 27th, Rules for special garbage are as follows:

- Everything possible must be boxed, bagged, tied or bundled to aid in collection;
- Maximum of 3 Large items per household
- Tree cuttings must not exceed 4 ft. or weigh over 50 lbs, securely tied bundles, branches 2" diameter or less
- No construction, demolition, or commercial waste;
- No liquid waste of any kind (paint or solvents);
- No motor vehicle parts;
- No propane tanks, other dangerous or toxic waste;
- No appliances containing coolant (fridge, freezer, air conditioner, water cooler, dehumidifier) – Call for details 506-276-3610 ext. 201 or visit: www.rsc12.ca

ROAD CONSTRUCTION

This summer's projects will be:



Centreville: Route 560 (Main Street) – Central Street (Route 110) to the south village limit(1.2km)

Bath: Route 565 (Mechanic Street) – Water Street area to the village limit (1.4km)

ROUTE 130 BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION

The Route 130 Bridge will remain in the current configuration until the work beneath the bridge is finished; Estimated around late June. At that point, traffic will be switched to the downriver lane and the work on the bridge deck will resume for the remainder of the construction season.
