Cardboard Classic Race Rules

Monday, February 16th 2026

Northern Carleton Civic Centre (40 McCain St. Florenceville-Bristol)
Judging at 10:00am **Race begins at 10:30am**

Our goal is to host a fun and successful event. In order to do this, we ask you to follow the rules outlined below.

Construction (Note: Best results if the front of the sled doesn't have any sharp edges, points, or square based.)

- Only cardboard may be used, held together by tape and glue.
- Inspection: All sleds **MUST** PASS an inspection before they will be allowed on the hill.
- Sled must be free of sharp edges, point objects or any other feature that may be deemed dangerous by judges.
- **Any other materials used (i.e. wood, metal, all other plastic, etc.) will result in immediate disqualification.**
- Inappropriate names, slogans, and or graphics will result in immediate disqualification.
- Judges will judge on **originality, construction, and design**. Prizes will be awarded.

Participation

- All participants must read, understand, and agree to the rules before registering a sled.
- All sled occupants **MUST** wear their own helmet (bicycle helmet, ski helmet, hockey helmet, etc.)
- All participants must have someone who will give their sled a push. This pusher must release the sled before the start line.
- To qualify as a finisher, you must be in or on your sled rather than chasing it or being chased by it as you cross the finish line.

Categories are as follows:

Ages: 4 - 8 & Ages: 9 - 12

- Races will consist of **Heats**.
- **Heat 1** will have all sleds complete one run down the hill and **must** cross the finish line **unassisted**. Successful sleds will advance to the next Heat. This will continue until one sled is remaining.
- If there is no clear winner, it will be decided by judges to go to a timed race, whereby the sled crossing the finish line with the fastest time will be deemed the **WINNER**.

Participants assume all risks associated with this event and will not hold the organizer liable.

Return this form back to the Tourism Dept. by February 13 in order to be permitted to compete.
