9. NEW BUSINESS:**1. Route 105 Vegetation Management**

Mayor and Council have received inquiries from residents regarding vegetation management along provincial roads in District of Carleton North. Provincial and provincially designated rural collector and local roads are overgrown resulting safety and visibility concerns. In addition, Mayor and Council have received inquires from residents and visitors regarding Route 105 – River Valley Scenic Drive. Vegetation is overgrown along this route obstructing views of the St. John River and reduces the scenic experience.

A letter will be sent the Minister of Transportation of Transportation and Infrastructure regarding vegetation management in District of Carleton North provincial highways.

A letter will be sent to the Minister of Tourism, Heritage, and Culture regarding the vegetation management along the River Valley Scenic Drive.

2. Route 130 Bridge: Status Report

The Route 130 Florenceville Bridge is open to two-lane traffic November 12th. The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure has completed the project.

3. Kenneth Windfarm Project Update
