

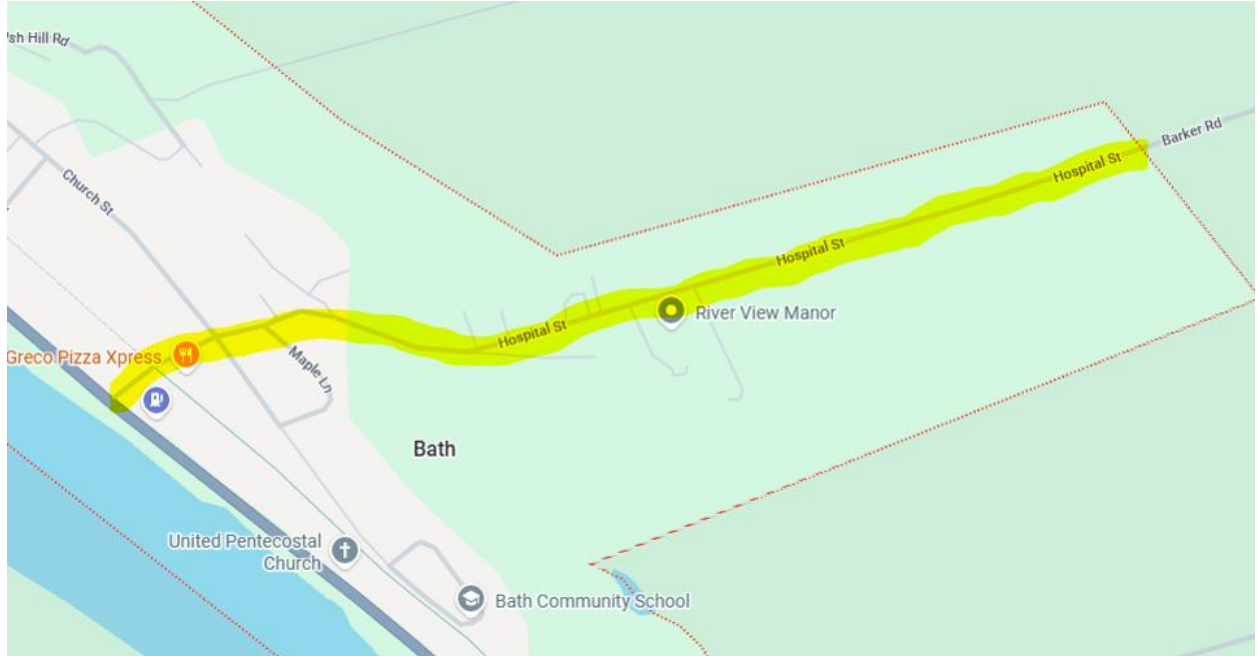
District of Carleton North Off Road Vehicle By-Law - Draft

Pursuant to the powers conferred by the Off-Road-Vehicle Act, RS.N.B. 1985, c 0-1.5 and its amendments, the Council of the District of Carleton North duly assembled enacts as follows:

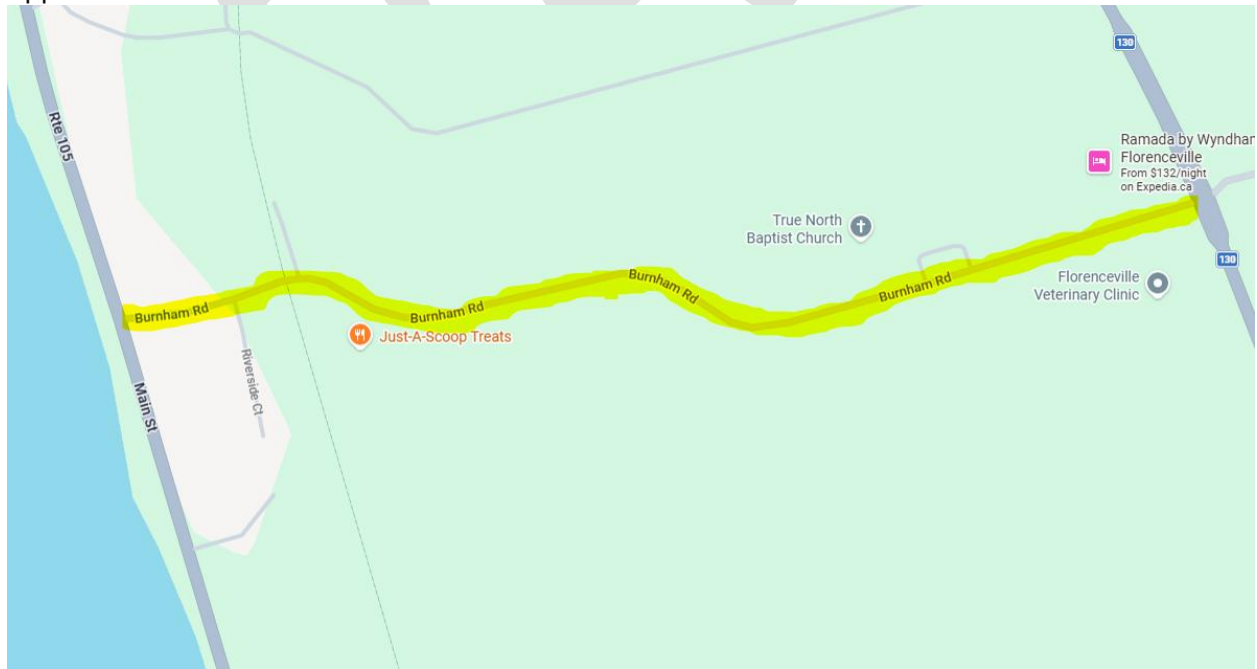
1. Purpose: To establish regulations respecting the use of Off-Road Vehicles on municipal streets
2. Definitions
 - a. Off-Road Vehicle
 - i. As defined in the Off-Road Vehicle Act, RS.N.B. 1985, c 0-1.5.
 - b. Shared Use Trail
 - i. A trail that is for both motorized and non-motorized use
3. General Provisions
 - a. The District of Carleton North authorizes Off-Road Vehicles to use a portion of municipal streets as specified below. The authorization to use a portion of said Streets applies only to Off-Road Vehicles complying with the Off-Road Vehicle Act and its regulations as well as any other applicable to this By-Law.
 - b. Nobody shall drive an Off-Road Vehicle on the streets within the District of Carleton North other than at the locations designated for this purpose as further set out below and, on a map, attached to this By-Law.
 - c. Nobody shall drive an Off-Road Vehicle on streets within the District of Carleton North without a valid driver's license
 - d. The following are designated as "Approved Off-Road Vehicle Routes" within the District of Carleton North.
 - i. East/West on Hospital Street as outlined by Appendix A
 - ii. East/West on Burnham Road as outlined by Appendix B

- iii. East/West on Waugh Road as outlined by Appendix C
 - e. Drivers and passengers of an Off-Road Vehicle shall wear, in an appropriate manner, a helmet that meets the standards prescribed by regulations made under the Motor Vehicle Act
 - f. Off-Road Vehicles shall be equipped with all necessary equipment, as described in the Off-Road Vehicle Act
 - g. Off-Road Vehicle drivers shall travel in the same direction as the traffic and shall move in single file, on the extreme right of the street
 - h. Off-Road Vehicles shall emit appropriate signals as required by the Motor Vehicle Act, and respect all traffic control devices
 - i. All other vehicles driving on the road must have priority
 - j. Off-Road Vehicles using the “Approved Off-Road Vehicle Routes” must be able to immediately provide a valid registration document, an insurance document, and have a license plate that is clearly visible
 - i. Off-Road Vehicles must also display a valid trail permit as required under the Off-Road Vehicle Act.
 - k. No person shall operate an off-road vehicle in such a way to disrupt or destroy the natural environment, create a nuisance by method of frequency of operation on any municipal property or upon any highway within the municipality.
4. Amendments
- a. The approval of this By-Law allows the CAO and/or delegate to make additions and/or subtractions to the “Approved Off-Road Vehicles Routes” without a motion or further action by council.
5. Offences
- a. Anyone who violated this By-Law commits a punishable offence and is liable to a fine of \$100.00
 - b. The District of Carleton North’s Public Safety Officer reserves the right to enforce this By-Law with all the powers entrusted to them by the District.
